NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR (NL) 2019

In January 2019, the Public Utilities Board published a report on the auto insurance system in that province. It did not make a recommendation for change, but it is expected that the government will change the governing legislation.

ONTARIO 2017

In April 2017, David Marshall submitted his comprehensive report to the Ontario government. The objective of the report was to lower the cost of insurance and improve the timeliness of the claims process. Marshall recommended a shift away from the adversarial process toward a model focussed on the wellness of the injured person.
